

Transport Action News - September 2022



Hello,

With most VIA trains now returning to pre-pandemic service levels the railway can once again look to the future. There is some good news in Minister Omar Alghabra's announcement this month in Windsor, which contained more nuance toward the possibility of near-term improvements, before the HFR project, although not the concrete announcement of increased services we might have hoped for.

Over the summer, the pressure to reinstate the remaining trains that were suspended due to the pandemic has increased, with Philip Lawrence MP and David Piccini MPP in Northumberland—Peterborough South both campaigning for the reinstatement of train 651 from Kingston, Belleville and Cobourg into Toronto in the morning and returning train 650 in the evening. Northumberland County organized a passenger survey, gathering hundreds of responses, and a rally will be held at the Cobourg station on September 9th at 2pm.

We have been asking both VIA Rail and the government about this service, and train 82 from London, since last fall and have yet to receive a clear explanation of the delay in reinstatement. With passenger numbers rebounding strongly, as documented in VIA Rail's second quarterly report, it is high time these trains were back on track. Your support, including sending letters, emails, and making calls to your local Member of Parliament, can help to bring this about.

The work of Transport Action would be impossible without the many dedicated volunteers who have contributed their time, energy, and knowledge over the years. This month we honour the memory of Dirk Partridge, who brought his extensive experience in the railway industry to the

role of volunteer national office manager.

Finally, if you are travelling by rail between Ottawa and Quebec City this fall, you may be in luck. With the first two brand-new Siemens trains now delivered, initial entry into service is expected soon.
