

## **Transport Action News - February 2023**

Hello,

There's encouraging news to share this month: An RFI for the replacement of VIA Rail's aging long-distance fleet has finally been issued. We'll be continuing to urge the government to keep the process moving forward as fast as possible and get the new trains ordered.

Following the chaos caused by the winter storm on December 23rd, House of Commons Standing Committee on Transport, Infrastructure and Communities invited VIA Rail executives and Transport Action Atlantic president Tim Hayman to testify before the committee on January 26th. The testimony included some questions for CN that we hope they'll answer.

We have launched an online letter writing campaign in support of the Vancouver Island Railway, gathering hundreds of responses in the first few days. Please send your own letter and share this link with your friends and family. Wherever you live in Canada, what happens in this case is likely set a precedent for the revival, or otherwise, of our regional train services.

Transport Action BC has also been engaged in consultations with Washington State DOT on the Amtrak Cascades Service Development Plan, which will explore options to add more trains and reduce running times for trains between Vancouver and Seattle. The second daily roundtrip train between both cities will resume on March 7, 2023.

Transport Action Ontario is urging a review of the Gardiner East Expressway - see below - and sponsoring a webinar series with Transport Futures that will explore highway issues including costs, road pricing, the impact of electric and autonomous vehicles, HOV and bus priority lanes, and *alternatives* to building highways. <u>Click here for more details and registration.</u>
