Hello,

Two steps forward, one step back. That's how it felt in Ontario this June with the announcement by GO Transit that their once-per-day London pilot project will be coming to end this fall coming hot on the heels of the announcement that VIA trains 82 and 83 between London and Toronto are going to be reinstated.

It was a similar feeling in Quebec, with two great funding announcements - most significantly, full funding to rehabilitate the railway line to Gapsé - being followed by the suspension of Amtrak's Adirondack due to the poor condition of CN's track north of the border. We are in frequent contact with US rail advocacy groups to coordinate our work on such cross-border issues, including Transport Action BC working with All Aboard Washington to suggest improvements to the Amtrak Cascades service.

Last month's meeting with Sarnia's Mayor Mike Bradley, a stalwart advocate of passenger rail for the city, and was followed by participation in a renewed regional study by Ontario's Ministry of Transportation and a meeting with the team from CPCS, who have been engaged by Transport Canada to explore options for more than doubling VIA Rail services in the region. With passenger numbers rebounding strongly, we'll also keep pushing for the return of trains 650 and 651 in eastern Ontario, and for rail and bus service increases throughout Canada.
