VIA Rail's modernized reservation system is now live, with many improvements including cheaper flexible fares and better accessibility, together with a new baggage policy we have some (ahem) "reservations" about... details of both are below.

The next major step in the transformation of VIA Rail must be securing the future of long-distance and remote services, the backbone of Canada's travel network. The stainless steel cars, despite the best efforts of maintenance teams as shown above, must now be replaced to keep these services operating into the next decade, let alone grow them. The RFI for new equipment was issued earlier this year, but government approval is needed to proceed, and the process of designing, building, testing, delivering new equipment is expected to take up to a decade.

We're delighted to have had an article on the importance of investing in VIA Rail's long-distance fleet featured in a special section on transport policy published by the <u>Hill Times</u> on November 13th. The newspaper is circulated throughout Parliament Hill, to all MPs' and Senators' offices,

Transport Canada, and equally importantly the Ministry of Finance. If VIA Rail doesn't get the go ahead for the procurement in Budget 2024, it will be a costly mistake.
